Thank you for taking time to consider supporting the work of Gospel Partners Trust. It is a great help to us if people can commit to giving regularly by standing order, but we recognise that some will prefer to make one-off gifts.

Please note: If you are a UK taxpayer you can increase the value of your gift by up to one-third if you make a Gift Aid Declaration.

Your involvement as a Partner

Partners can give to the general work of the Trust or choose to be identified with a specific area of work, either as a one-off gift or as an ongoing donation. Please indicate your wishes on the "my involvement as a Partner" form.

We will keep you informed about the work of the Trust, and will arrange for Partners interested in the work of specific individuals or ministries to receive their prayer letter.

Giving to the work of the Trust

Donations may be made by:

- Direct bank transfer (see bank details below)
- Cheque (payable to "Gospel Partners Trust")
- Bank Standing Order
- CAF vouchers (see below)

Standing Orders

Please fill in a Standing Order form and return it to the Giving Secretary. You may change the amount of your donation at any time; just send the Giving Secretary a new Standing Order form and indicate in the space provided that it supersedes your previous instructions.

CAF vouchers

Gift Vouchers from Charities Aid Foundation and similar organisations are very welcome. Please make them out to "Gospel Partners Trust". (We can provide details of Christian organisations which have much lower fees than CAF. Contact us on info@gospelpartnerstrust.org.)

Tax-Efficient Giving

If you pay tax in the UK please complete the Gift Aid Declaration form which will enable us to increase the value of your donation by claiming back the basic-rate tax you have paid. To qualify for Gift Aid tax relief you must pay UK income and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax reclaimed

There is no minimum amount or minimum term for Gift Aid, and a single Gift Aid Declaration can now run indefinitely.

If you stop paying tax or need to cancel your declaration please contact the Giving Secretary at the Trust address.

Higher-rate tax payers

The Gospel Partners Trust reclaims tax at the basic rate. You can claim additional tax relief (up to the higher rate) by declaring your Gift Aid donations on your Tax Return.

Changes in your situation

You may cancel your standing order and/or Gift Aid declaration at any time by notifying the Giving Secretary. Please also notify the Giving Secretary of any changes to your name, address or tax situation.
